Departure:

Friday, August 28th

- For those leaving Friday afternoon, plan to be at the church between 3:30 3:45pm
- <u>Leave</u> from the church at 4:00 pm. Drive to the campground. The drive to the Hiwassee is about 4.5 hours (including time change).

Saturday, August 29th

- For those leaving Saturday morning, please be at the church between 6:30am 6:45am.
- <u>Leave</u> from the church at 7:00 am. Drive to the campground.

- Friday dinner: we'll stop somewhere along the way, so bring money for dinner.
- Grubmasters will serve Saturday breakfast, lunch, and dinner and Sunday breakfast and lunch.

- <u>Climbing</u>: A small group of older scouts will be participating in a climbing trip on Saturday in lieu of rafting the Hiwassee. David Boyer and Curtis Capeling will lead this group.

Gear:

- Attire: Scouts need to wear their Class B shirts
- This is car camping, so plan your camping gear accordingly. The group campsite does not have trees for hammocks, so bring a tent.
- For the Hiwassee/climbing, bring a water bottle and sunscreen. It's going to be HOT!!
- If you bring a wallet or camera, be sure to have a waterproof bag in which you can store them.
- You are discouraged from bringing anything on the Ocoee River that might fall out of the raft.

Cost:

- The amount, which each person owes will be provided at a future date. Please bring <u>checks</u> with you
 (no cash please make checks payable to Troop 93).
- Bring money for dinner on Friday night, as we will stop somewhere along the way to the campground.
